SPARKLING WINE



Luc Belaire Rare Rosé (France) **1162**

Red fruit bouquet, with strawberry & blackcurrant on the palate

CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Reyneke Biodynamic Reserve (Stellenbosch) **2100**

Black cherry & blackcurrant aromas presented on the nose, backed up by spicy notes that eventually turn into darker undertones of black pepper & cedar

PINOTAGE



Kanonkop Estate (Stellenbosch) **890**

Vibrant aromas of ripe plums, cinnamon & vanilla. Densely packed flavours of berries, wild bramble & spicy Christmas cake

Ashbourne (Hemel-en-Aarde Valley) **1490**

Pure lifted aromas of tea rose, plum & black cherry that combine perfectly with hints of cinnamon & nutmeg spice, with a backdrop of summer rain

PINOT NOIR



Hamilton Russel Vineyards (Hemel-en-Aarde) **1165**

This wine is not overtly fruity, soft & "sweet" & generally shows hints of that alluring savoury "primal" character along with a dark, spicy, complex primary fruit perfume

Domaine Jacques-Frederic Magnier NSG **3900**

"Clos de la Marechale" Premier Cru

(Nuits Saint George - Burgundy, France)

Subject to availability

A markedly earthy nose features notes of various dark berries & hints of game & similar green tea nuances

RED BLENDS & UNUSUAL BLENDS



Saronsberg Full Circle (Tulbagh) **1100**

Subject to availability

Deep, dark purple in colour with ripe plum & red berries being prominent in flavour & floral tones & spice as undertones on the nose

BORDEAUX STYLE BLENDS

The Last Elephant (Coastal Region) **990**
The nose brims with moreish dark fruit, showing blackcurrants, cherries, mulberries along with cedar wood, lead pencil & cigar box aromas

Fusion V (Stellenbosch) **1350**
Subject to availability
Moderately full bodied, fine grained yet polished tannins, red cherry bouquet, sweet spice & subtle oak on the nose

Vilafonte Series M (Paarl) **1950**
Subject to availability
An opulent & fruit-driven Merlot & Malbec dominant blend, displaying seductive aromas of ripe mulberry, blackberry & sweet spices

Babylonstoren Nebukadnesar (Franschhoek) **2900**
Crafted with a good balance of vibrant multilayered dark red fruits supported by tight, well-honed tannins. Handles the oak effortlessly. Opulent yet sophisticated with long, compelling finish

Book XV11 (Stellenbosch) **6900**
Subject to availability
This wine has a fine, firm tannin structure with acidity that adds to its complexity. Shows hints of black cherries & black currants, layered with a rich graphite minerality, rounded out by a touch of sweet spice nutmeg & underlying vanilla

MAGNUMS (1.5L)

Boschendal Nicolas (Stellenbosch) **800**
On the nose, red cherries, fresh plums, mulberries and cassis are complimented by pencil-shavings, dark chocolate and spicy cigar box flavours

De Grendel Elim Shiraz (Durbanville) **1700**
This Shiraz conveys black cherry, lavender & blackberry aromas. It offers a rich taste with solid but soft tannins, backed by well-unified oak. It is complex & multi-dimensional with layers of mulberries & white pepper

Meerlust Rubicon (Stellenbosch) **2200**
Medium bodied wine with a forward dark fruit flavour of cassis & mulberry followed by a lithe tannic structure fleshed out with juicy fruit

Tokara Director's Reserve Red (Stellenbosch) **2300**
Flavours are those of dark cherries, blackberries & ripe plum skin. Sumptuous & full there is a hint of spice on the mid-palate which leads to fine, firm tannins on the finish
